# Issuer did not cooperate; based on best available information

#### Nature of Non-cooperation:

The rating was due for a review in August 2015, however, since no information was received from your end, the rating was migrated to 'Not Reviewed' category in April 2016. Post that also BWR took up with the issuer to provide required information over emails and phone calls during the period. Despite the best efforts of BWR to get the minimum required information for a review, the entity has not provided the same. In the absence of adequate information from the Company and non-receipt of No Default Statement, BWR is unable to assess the company's performance, its ability to service its debt and maintain a valid rating.

#### About the Company (as available in Aug 2014):

Amrapali Hospitality Services Pvt Ltd (AHSPL) was incorporated in 2008 by Amrapali Group with an objective to build and manage a three star hotel in Deoghar, Jharkhand. The company has entered into an agreement with UP Hotels Ltd to operate the hotel under their brand name 'Clarks Inn'. As per the agreement, UP Hotels Ltd will provide managerial assistance to AHSPL and the company will pay them a management fee.



**Limitations of the Rating:**

Information availability risk is a key factor in the assessment of credit risk and non-cooperation by the issuer to provide required information for a review of the assigned rating may also be accompanied by financial stress.
