



RBI Policy Pause Reflects Confidence In Growth–Inflation Balance

The RBI's decision to keep rates unchanged signals confidence in India's macro stability, with policymakers balancing steady growth and moderating inflation amid global uncertainties. Experts say the pause also reflects comfort with current macro fundamentals and a focus on ensuring effective transmission of past rate cuts. Overall, the stance suggests a cautious "wait-and-watch" approach rather than an immediate easing bias. Vikrant Chaturvedi noted that the policy pause "reflects confidence in India's macro resilience and the delicate growth–inflation balance."



Vikrant Chaturvedi, Associate Director – Research at Brickwork Ratings, said, "The RBI MPC's unanimous decision to keep the repo rate unchanged at 5.25 per cent and maintain a neutral stance signals confidence in India's macroeconomic resilience, with growth holding firm even as inflation remains decisively benign." He added that upward revisions to early FY27 GDP growth projections underscore the strength of domestic demand drivers, while stable policy rates remain supportive of debt-servicing capacity and ratings stability.
