[Benchmark indices](#) opened on a muted note on Monday morning before staging a modest recovery in early trade, as investors continued to digest the previous session's sharp sell-off triggered by the [Union Budget 2026-27](#).

The [Sensex](#) opened at 80,555.68 against its previous close of 80,722.94 and was trading at 80,966.47, up 243.53 points or 0.30 per cent at 9.45 AM. The [Nifty](#) opened at 24,796.50 compared to its previous close of 24,825.45 and was trading at 24,873.25, up 47.80 points or 0.19 per cent.
