2022 GDP is likely to grow at 10-10.5%: Report

Domestic rating agency Brickwork Ratings revised its gross domestic product (GDP) growth forecast on Monday from the previous 9% growth forecast to 10-10.5% this fiscal year.

Many economic growth indicators suggest a faster-than-expected recovery in economic activity, he said. A credit rating agency said in a report released Monday that it would “revise the 2010 GDP forecast from the previous 9% to 10-10.5%.”

GDP growth in the second quarter of 2010 is expected to be 8.3% (year-on-year) against the backdrop of a 7.4% reduction in the second quarter of 2009. The country’s GDP grew at 20.1 percent in the first quarter of 2022.
